CFO/ Arbiter: Officials are encouraged to join CFO. For the NE10 Staff all of the officials must be registered. Membership of the CFO is a requirement for any post-season assignments. Dues for the CFO are payable on their website.

<u>Physical Forms and Spring Test Answer Sheets</u>: All officials are required to be physically certified by a doctor prior to the clinic. If your insurance company will not allow you to meet this Aug 3 date you will be required to supply a note from the doctor approving your clinic participation. Remember, you will still be required to be physically certified prior to your first scrimmage. The form has been updated for this season, the Physical Form can be found on ZebraWeb. Please bring the doctor signed Physical form and the answer sheets from the spring preseason exams to the clinic. *No need to mail anything in advance, bring forms to the clinic Aug 3*!

<u>Appearance</u>: We always talk about controlling the things under your specific control. You should be well into a conditioning/exercise program. You will be expected to attend the Clinic in excellent physical condition and athletic appearance. Please do not place yourself in a position that could penalize your assignments. Work to stay in shape all year long.

<u>Update ZebraWeb Profile Information, Close out Dates</u>: Please update your personal profile immediately. This should include a recent phot with jacket and tie. If you need to block out and dates in the Fall please get that completed **by June 14**.
